July 20, 2019

The 2019 Becoming an Outdoors Woman[®] Fall Workshop registration cost is \$250.00. There are a limited number of BOW bursaries available for partial payment of \$150.00. The remainder of the registration fee (\$100.00) is the responsibility of the applicant and must be paid on registration with Eventbrite. Bursary applications must be received by midnight **July 20, 2019**. Successful bursary recipients will receive a PROMO code to use with the Eventbrite online registration opening July 27, 2019.

Receiving a bursary does not give you priority in classes. You should still register as soon as registration is open to get your first-choice classes. Preference to receive bursaries will be given to residents of Nova Scotia who are first-time participants, and either full-time students, single parents or from low-income households. Please note - those who have previously received BOW funding are not eligible.
